Vision 2050 A \$180,000+ Waste of Our Tax Dollars

The Owen Sound Current petitioned via the Freedom of Information Act to obtain details of the Vision 2050 Survey. The editor, Miranda Miller has done a fantastic job of pursuing and publishing the results and briefs. They had previously been withheld by council.
